>> Approach

- Make sure your writing is well organised and clearly paragraphed, starting with an introduction and ending with a conclusion summarising your opinion.
- You need to write about the two elements in the notes, as well as adding an idea of your own. This third idea must be different from the other two, and cannot simply be your conclusion at the end of the essay. Think about what your own idea will be before you start writing. Read the question carefully and write a brief plan so you know what to include in each paragraph.
- The register should be neutral or semi-formal, and even if you have strong opinions on the topic, you should try to express them in an objective way and look at both sides of the argument.

▶ Model answer

State the general topic in the first paragraph.

You can present the disadvantages of the statement or situation in a separate paragraph.

Sum up the main points and say whether there are more advantages than disadvantages. Show clearly whether you agree, disagree or partly agree with the statement. The use of the internet is now widespread. It is part of most people's lives, and some believe that its overall effects are harmful to society.

As we all know, the internet makes it easy to keep in touch with friends or family, for example by using social networking sites. You can also find out about events in the wider world almost as soon as they have happened. Moreover, students use the internet to find useful information for homework and college projects.

On the other hand, there are disadvantages too. For example, people can spend so much time chatting to friends on their computers that they rarely meet them face-to-face. Furthermore, the news that people see on the Internet is not always accurate. Accuracy can also be a problem for students using the Internet for their homework: unless it is from a reliable website, it may be incorrect.

On balance, I think there are more advantages than disadvantages to using the internet. As long as people are careful and do not automatically believe everything they see on it, then the internet can be a positive part of their lives.

One way of writing this kind of essay is to present the advantages of the statement or situation in one paragraph. Use the two points in the notes and add one of your own (here, the third point is about using the internet to help with homework).

Use linking words or expressions to list the main points (advantages or disadvantages) in your paragraph.
